Monday, August 19th

Meet and Greet

Drop off supplies, meet teachers, get new year paperwork, calendar, etc.

Arrival

- Supervision is provided beginning at 7:40 a.m. NO supervision is provided prior to 7:40 a.m.
- Grades K–4 are to assemble on the right side of the building (as you face our school doors). Grades 5–8 are to assemble on the left side of the building (church side). Teachers will be in those areas holding their grade level signs so students know where to go. *This procedure is for the first week of school only.*
- Students are not to be anywhere on the campus except for the gathering areas. There is a lot of morning traffic on our block and we want to keep the students safe. Also, once your child enters the gathering areas or gets off of the bus, they may not leave the campus.
- At 7:55 a.m., the morning bell will ring and the students will enter the building through the side entrances with their homeroom in a single file, silent line. Students who arrive after the rest of the school has gone into the building must enter through the main doors. We have arranged our arrival procedure for orderly and safe entry into the building, and to give the students a sense of their class community. Please strive to get your child to school on time.
- After the first week of school (beginning on August 26th), Grades K-4 will gather inside the building on the lower level. Grades 5-8 will gather on the first floor. Grades K-4 enter the gathering area through the lower level doors. Grades 5-8 enter the building through the side glass doors.
- **Remember: The traffic pattern on Baxter Avenue has changed. During arrival and dismissal times, Baxter traffic will be one way in the *same* direction as Forman. For those of you who circle the block, turn right on East 67th to Chambers. Turn right onto Chambers and then again right onto East 65th and this will bring you to either Forman or Baxter. In essence, instead of circling the block onto Baxter, you will circle in the other direction onto Chambers. Thank you for observing the new traffic pattern to assist us in keeping our students safe.**

Uniforms

- Schoolbelles is where the school uniform is purchased, specifically jumpers, skirts, and polos. The gym uniform is purchased through the school.
- Students may wear the Saint Stanislaus School gym uniform through the end of August because of the heat of the building when we first open. *All students must be in the regular school uniform for the opening school Mass on Wednesday, August 28th.*

Tuition

- Registration is \$150, which covers the cost of Religion books, technology access, and lunchroom supervision.

- *If you received a **new** voucher this year, you must turn in your signed award letter prior to the first day of school. Acceptance forms for renewal scholarships also need to be turned in the first week of school.*

Calendar

- The calendar will be in the parent packet distributed during our Meet and Greet.

Parent Portal

- We continue to use the same student management system this school year: TeacherEase. If you are new to our school, login information will be given to you by September 8th. Please utilize this system to monitor student work.
- We are working towards going digital as much as possible. Please make sure TeacherEase emails do not end up in spam. Also, ClassDojo is used for weekly parent newsletters, homework postings, and general communications. Monthly calendars will continue to be paper so you can put them on your refrigerator!

Miscellaneous

- Both breakfast and lunch will be served starting on the first day of school for grades 1-8 (August 20th). Kindergarten breakfast and lunch will be served beginning on August 26th. Breakfast and lunch are free for all students. Snack bar will continue to be offered.
- Students are permitted to have water bottles in school. No pop, juice, Gatorade, tea, etc. Just plain water in a container that will not prove to be distracting or cumbersome for your child.
