### ***Arrival***

- Supervision is provided beginning at 7:40 a.m. NO supervision is provided prior to 7:40 a.m.
- Grades K–4 are to assemble on the right side of the building (as you face our school doors). Grades 5–8 are to assemble on the left side of the building (church side). Teachers will be in those areas holding their grade level signs so students know where to go. *This procedure is for the first week of school only.*
- Students are not to be anywhere on the campus except for the gathering areas. There is a lot of morning traffic on our block and we want to keep the students safe. Also, once your child enters the gathering areas or gets off of the bus, they may not leave the campus.
- At 7:55 a.m., the morning bell will ring and the students will enter the building through the side entrances with their homeroom in a single file, silent line. Students who arrive after the rest of the school has gone into the building must enter through the main doors. We have arranged our arrival procedure for orderly and safe entry into the building, and to give the students a sense of their class community. Please strive to get your child to school on time.
- After the first week of school (beginning on August 24<sup>th</sup>), Grades K-2 will gather inside the building on the lower level. Grades 3-5 will gather on the second floor, and 6-8 will gather on the third floor. Grades K-2 enter the gathering area through the lower level doors. Grades 3-5 enter the building through the Nazareth Park side glass doors. Grade 6- 8 enter through the church side glass doors. **These changes have been put in place to minimize the number of students gathering in one space at one time.**

### ***Uniforms***

- Schoolbelles is where the school uniform is purchased, specifically jumpers, skirts, and polos. The gym uniform is purchased through the school.
- Students may wear the Saint Stanislaus School gym uniform through the end of September. **This is a change for 2020/2021.**

### ***Tuition***

- Registration is \$150, which covers the cost of Religion books, technology access, and lunchroom supervision.
- *If you received a **new** voucher this year, you must turn in your signed award letter prior to the first day of school. Acceptance forms for renewal scholarships also need to be turned in the first week of school.*

### ***Calendar***

- The calendar will be in the parent packet distributed during our Meet and Greet. It is also posted on our website.

### ***Parent Portal***

- We continue to use the same student management system this school year: TeacherEase. If you are new to our school, login information will be given to you by September 8th. Please utilize this system to monitor student work.
- ClassDojo is used for weekly parent newsletters, homework postings, and general communications. Monthly calendars will continue to be paper so you can put them on your refrigerator!

### ***Miscellaneous***

- Both breakfast and lunch will be served starting on the first day of school for grades 1-8 (August 18<sup>th</sup>). Kindergarten breakfast and lunch will be served beginning on August 24<sup>th</sup>. Breakfast and lunch are free for all students. Snack bar will not be offered until further notice due to safety restrictions.
- Students are permitted to have water bottles in school. No pop, juice, Gatorade, tea, etc. Just plain water in a container that will not prove to be distracting or cumbersome for your child.

### ***Coronavirus Conditions***

- There are new forms and documents which will be given to you regarding our modified school operations due to the coronavirus. Some of these are informational; some you will need to complete. These documents will be posted on Class Dojo, found on our website under the *Current Families* tab, and available in the main office.
- Safety and hygiene will obviously be a priority during the school year and it is expected that all students, parents, and visitors will comply with our requirements.
- The Re-opening Plan explains the expectations of both the school and our families. It is located on our website.

New school years open the door for hope and blessings. Our challenges this year are many, but as a school community working together, we will be successful!
